

Parent Service Program

The parent service program exists to help raise parent awareness and involvement in the education of their children in a manner that directly affects the school's programs. Since parents are the "primary educator", it is essential they participate in the "schooling" process. The intent of this program is positive in nature and supportive in design. There is a place for everyone's talents. Thirty volunteer hours per family are required each school year. It is the parent's responsibility to volunteer for appropriate activities in order to work the required hours and to see that records of hours worked are recorded on the brown envelope. You will be assessed \$20.00 per hour not fulfilled. This will be due the last day of school. Failure to fulfill hours or pay may result in hindering release of student's records, report cards, etc.

Summer Camp

St. Olaf Catholic School holds a summer camp for those students who need summer daycare. This will be for students entering K or above. The camp is open from 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. The cost is \$35 per day for the first child. Each additional child is \$30. There is a \$30 registration fee per child.

The mornings will include arts and crafts, games, and outside activities. The afternoons will include away from the school field trips. The transportation provided will be safe (Judge school bus) with a qualified driver. A calendar with the scheduled activities is provided.
